Rules & Regulations

General Rules

All sales are final. No returns, refunds, or exchanges are permitted. The buyer is responsible for being aware of any restrictions, exclusions, expiration dates, etc. Personal services such as private dinners, etc. will be scheduled at a mutually agreed upon date unless a specific date is given. Once items are purchased, they are the responsibility of the bidder and Clifford PTO relinquishes responsibility for the item.

Donated items and services are often bundled into a package. Grouped items do not have to be used at the same time. Please review each item's restrictions and expiration dates.

In the event of a dispute in any aspect of the auction and raffle, the Fundraising Committee is the final authority and their decision shall be considered final.

Clifford PTO and its Fundraising Committee members have not appraised auction items or estimated their fair market value. The donors, in good faith, have furnished the estimated value. All property is sold "as-is" and items are non-returnable to the donating vendor. Gift certificates have no cash value.

In determining whether any part of the price paid for an auction item constitutes a charitable contribution, please seek advice from your tax consultant.

Check-In Procedure

Registration will open at 6:00pm. Provide your credit card information. This is mandatory as you will be responsible for all items you have bid on and "won", as well as to expedite the check out procedure. You will be given a numbered bid paddle and a wristband. All purchases including the bar will be tracked using your bid number.

Check-Out Procedure

Before leaving, visit the payment table. Turn in your bid paddle number and take home your winning items. You will receive a copy of your invoice via email within a week after the auction ends. In the email, you will be offered various payment options including check or credit card. If you can pay your invoice by sending a check, it saves the PTO credit card processing fees. Please select your preferred option or your credit card will be charged accordingly to the invoice on Saturday, September 29, 2018.

Silent Auction Process

To bid on an item in the Silent Auction, write your bidder number next to the amount on the corresponding bid sheet. Your bidder number on the bid sheet constitutes a legal contract to buy.

Silent Auction - Guaranteed Purchase

“Guaranteed Purchase” amounts will be indicated on each bid sheet. For most items and packages, the “Guaranteed Purchase” amount is equal to the value, plus at least 50%. Bidders may at any time write this amount in as their bid, along with their bid number. The item/package will close immediately with their “Guaranteed Purchase” bid and they shall be designated as the winning bidder. No further bids will be allowed after the “Guaranteed Purchase” amount is bid on the bid sheet.

Silent Auction tables’ closing time will be announced by our auctioneer. As tables close, the winning bidder number will be displayed next to the item, please check and see if you won the item or check at the checkout payment table.

Live Auction

The Auctioneer will present each Live Auction item. To bid on a live auction item, a bidder will raise his/her bid number in the air indicating they are willing to bid the amount being announced by the auctioneer. The auctioneer will recognize the highest bidder at the time and ask for additional bids. If multiple bidders indicate a bid at the same time, the auctioneer will determine which bid is being accepted. The auctioneer may close the bidding on an item at any time by indicating it is “sold”. Multiple bids may be accepted if duplicate items are available. The highest bidder acknowledged by the auctioneer shall be the purchaser.


Cash Bar

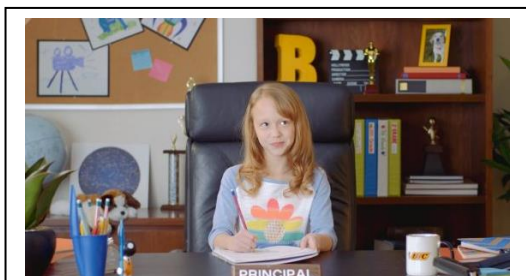

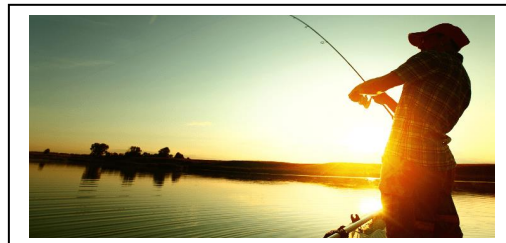

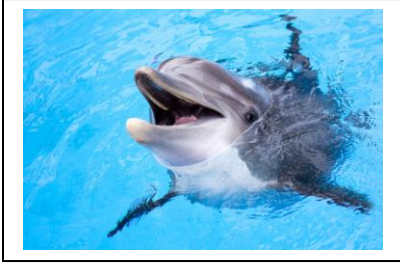
