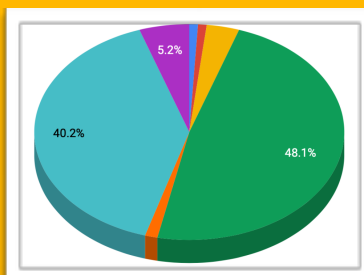


Bus Line 73 available from
